RESOLUTION DE-30/12

Mexico. Loan 2718A/OC-ME to Braskem Idesa S.A.P.I.

The Board of Executive Directors

RESOLVES:

That the President of the Bank, or such representative as he shall designate, is authorized in the name and on behalf of the Bank, to enter into such agreements as may be necessary with Braskem Idesa S.A.P.I., a *sociedad anónima promotora de inversión* incorporated and organized under the laws of Mexico, to grant it financing to develop, construct and operate an integrated petrochemical complex in Mexico. The financing will consist of an A loan for the amount of up to US\$300 million from the Ordinary Capital resources of the Bank, and may include a B loan for additional resources to be contributed by commercial banks or other financial institutions through the subscription of participation agreements with the Bank (the “B Loan”). The financing will be subject to the terms and conditions indicated in the Executive Summary of the Loan Proposal contained in document PR-3692-2. The President of the Bank, or such representative as he shall designate, is also authorized to subscribe the participation agreements with the commercial banks or financial institutions participating in the B Loan and to execute any other agreements as may be necessary with other parties to complete this transaction.
