The Ministry of the Attorney General and Legal Affairs has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments under the project Gender and Property Registration Study. This involves the research and analysis of women's land and property ownership within Trinidad and Tobago and increasing awareness among women of their legal rights in land ownership and property registration. The main activities are:

- 1. Conduct of Women's Property Registration Diagnostic
- 2. Design of a Gender and Property Registration Communication Module.
- 3. Facilitation of a Gender and Land Registration Workshop with Registrar General Department

The Registrar General's Department now requests CVs from eligible individuals for the Gender and Property Registration Study. The successful candidate would be expected to have a combination of both academic qualifications together with related experience. This would require; A Master's degree in anthropology, sociology, economics or any of the Social Sciences or a field related to land use or agriculture, with at least five (5) years' experience in the field of qualitative and quantitative data collection for the production of socio-economic diagnostics in the Latin America and Caribbean region.
