

| Safeguard Performance Rating - Rationale: | CDB have undertaken 3 sub-loans with IDB resources under the Program. Waivers have been granted with respect to disclosure, an area where to date CDB have been unable to comply with the requirements of the loan. There is a committment to address this issue. A second area for improvement is in the monitoring of the environmental and social requirements once projects are approved. Both will be particularly important for IDB monitoring in 2015, as it is expected that the 4th and final sub loan will be a Category A dam rehabilitation project. |
