Dear Minister Jordan,

I am pleased to inform you that, in response to the request of the Ministry of Finance dated August 14, 2015, the Inter-American Development Bank (the "Bank"), approved on November 24, 2015, a non-reimbursable Technical Cooperation for the amount of one hundred and fifty thousand dollars of the United States of America (US\$150,000) (the "Contribution") to be financed with the resources of the Small and Vulnerable Countries Program (the "Technical Cooperation").

The objective of the Technical Cooperation is to generate publicly available data on crime victimization for: (i) use in the design of crime and violence prevention policies and programs in Guyana; (ii) use in the evaluation of said policies and programs; and, (iii) assessing the prevalence of crime and violence in Guyana and placing these data in a regional and global context. The specific objectives are: (i) survey design and training; (ii) data collection; and, (iii) data analysis.

The execution and disbursement period of the Technical Cooperation will be twenty-four (24) months from the date of approval of the Technical Cooperation.

The Bank will select and contract the consulting services necessary for the implementation of the activities provided in this Technical Cooperation pursuant to its current policies and procedures. The Cooperative Republic of Guyana undertakes to assist the Consultants and the Bank in the performance of their tasks, and provide the necessary technical, logistic, and administrative support required for the execution of the Technical Cooperation in relation to the activities that will take place in the Cooperative Republic of Guyana.

The financing of the consulting services detailed in this Agreement does not imply any commitment whatsoever by the Bank to finance, wholly or partially, any other program or project that might directly or indirectly result from the execution of this Technical Cooperation. The

opinions of the Consultants shall not commit the Bank to the same position. The Bank reserves the right to express any comments or reservations regarding such opinions as it may deem appropriate.
