The Government of Jamaica has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB), Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) and European Union-Caribbean Investment Facility (EU-CIF) toward the cost of the Energy Management and Efficiency Programme (EMEP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments under the contract for the deep energy retrofitting of seven (7) Government hospitals.

The PCJ intends to prequalify contractors and/or firms for the design, supply and installation services for deep energy retrofitting of seven (7) public hospitals in Jamaica. This procurement process requires bidders to have experience in Electrical Works and Energy Efficiency/Renewable Energy Retrofits; with specific experience implementing energy savings and solar PV systems valuing at least US\$1 million.

Prequalification will be conducted through the procedures specified in the Inter-American Development Bank's: *Policies for the Procurement of Goods and Works financed by the Inter-American Development Bank*, GN-2349-9, the EU Rules on participation in procurement procedures and grants (<u>PRAG</u>) annex A2a, and the Government of Jamaica (GoJ) Public Sector Procurement Procedures. Prequalification is open to all eligible and qualified bidders as defined in the Inter-American Development Bank policies and the European Union eligibility rules and procedures. Bidders eligible to participate are those who are nationals of member countries of the IDB and EU eligible countries.
