Who should submit proposals?

- Public institutions (from IDB borrowing member countries) seeking to implement their own impact assessment for any institutional capacity building intervention.
- Academic, research, for-profit or non-profit organizations (registered in any of the 48 member countries), interested in conducting an impact assessment, and in partnership with a public institution with an institutional initiative.

Why you should submit your proposal?

Public institutions will have the opportunity to

- » Win up to \$50,000 to apply their own impact assessment methodology on an
- institutional capacity intervention;
- » Validate the intervention's impact through quantitative measurements;
- » Communicate the assessment results to citizens or general public;
- » Improve the design of future public policies.

Evaluating agencies will have the opportunity to

- » Win up to \$50,000 to implement a methodology they have designed;
- » Test and improve the methodology and promote its success;
- » Establish and/or strengthen a relationship and partner with a public institution.

The eight winning organizations will have the opportunity to work closely with IDB specialists to enhance their methodology. Furthermore, winners will be eligible to receive up to an additional \$25,000 to replicate the methodology in the region and to be recognized as leaders in the area of institutional capacity building and impact assessment.
