# LONG-STANDING TRADITION

OF COLLABORATION WITH GOVERNMENTS, MULTILATERAL AND BILATERAL ORGANIZATIONS, AND INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCIES ON PROJECTS AND PROGRAMS.

## EXAMPLES:

Austria, Finland, Germany, Italy, Japan, Spain and the United Kingdom have supported more than 60 technical assistance and investment grants through the Sustainable Energy and Climate Change multi-donor fund.

The IDB has established strong ties with China, Korea and Japan's cofinancing institutions, securing contributions of \$1.6b.

The Nordic Development Fund provided \$29.2m to the IDB Climate Change initiative supporting 13 projects.

The IDB and the Government of Spain's partnership provides more than \$500 million in grants for projects to expand water and sanitation services to low-income families.

The Latin American Investment Facility of the European Commission, together with the IDB, EIB, AECID, CABEI and Nordic Investment Fund, grew to \$89million to promote energy efficiency, sustainable urban development, water and sanitation and climate change for regional and country programs in Mexico, Peru, Colombia, Chile and Brazil.
