Bolivia: Program to Support Employment (BO-L1051)

Challenge: Employment services in Latin America have the potential to become real assets for the labor market by matching employers and job seekers in a timely, effective and relevant manner. However, most employment services in the region have limited coverage.

Objective: The objective of this operation is to support the Ministry of Labor, Employment and Social Security in its efforts to expand the coverage and effectiveness of its policies and programs, helping to achieve better integration of workers into the labor market.

This objective will be achieved through a program comprising the following three components: (i) expansion of the Employment Service; (ii) a program to support employment for adults; and (iii) planning, analysis of employment policies, and evaluation.
