Dear Requesters,

I hereby notify you that we have reviewed your Request and are proceeding to register it in accordance to paragraph 20 of the MICI Policy (MI-47-6).

As previously informed, the registration is an administrative process that sets the beginning of the eligibility analysis of the Request based on the admissibility criteria established in paragraph 22 of the Policy. Here are the steps that will be followed in the coming weeks:

1. Management Response: the team responsible for the project is simultaneously being informed of the registration of your Request so that they can respond to the issues listed in it, offering the perspective of Bank Management. To elaborate and send this response they have a maximum term of 21 business days starting today. (**September 11, 2017**)

2. Eligibility Analysis: once we receive the response from Management, within a maximum period of 21 business days, we will be issuing our determination through an eligibility memorandum. The deadline for issuing the memorandum is **October 11, 2017**.

We inform you that a file will be opened shortly of your Request in the [Public Registry](#) of MICI website, where you can consult the process in which your application is located and where all documents of a public nature of the case will be published.
