

We finance the design, implementation, and evaluation of innovative and scalable approaches to improve the development of children ages 0-5 of the most disadvantaged populations in Latin America and the Caribbean.











Through grant financing and evidence generation, the ECD Innovation Fund provides an incentive for governments to try innovative approaches on Early Childhood Development (ECD).



WHY PARTNER WITH US?

The Inter-American Development Bank has invested over 4 billion dollars in more than 140 projects with an ECD component in the last 20 years. To carry out an ambitious operational and analytical agenda on ECD, the IDB has consolidated a team that brings together cutting-edge technical knowledge and a large network of partners in government, civil society, and academia. Through its projects, the IDB is in a privileged spot within the continuum of

scalability, where it can work with governments in the implementation of effective, innovative ideas at scale.

Any government, university, or private sector institution can apply. We seek innovative ideas that have the potential to be scaled up. We want to generate evidence about their impact. Projects must be in the Inter-American Development Bank's borrowing member countries.

HOW ARE PROJECTS SELECTED?

FUNDING

- Organizations submit project ideas on a rolling basis
- Project ideas are screened to verify they meet eligibility criteria
- Out of the pool of eligible ideas, the ECD Innovation Fund partners jointly prioritize a subset that is invited to submit a proposal
- The ECD Innovation Fund partners evaluate project propsals and jointly select projects for the next funding cycle
- Teams are notified about funding decisions
