Dear Requesters,

I hereby announce across this platform and through your Representative, that after analyzing the information that was sent we are proceeding to register your Request, complying with paragraph 20 of MICI's Policy. Likewise, we are confirming your request to keep your identity confidential that you have requested before the Mechanism.

The registration is an administrative process to commence the analysis of eligibility in which our capability of attending your Request can be done or not, based upon the criteria of paragraph 22 of the Policy. Hereafter, I listed the steps that will be followed during the upcoming weeks.

- 1) **Management's Response:** the team who is responsible for the Project is simultaneously being informed of the Request's registration so that they can respond to the aspects they pose, thus offering the perspective of the Bank's Management. In order to elaborate this response, they have a limit of 21 business days starting today. The date to receive Management's response is the upcoming **July 18th, 2018**.
- 2) **Analysis of Eligibility:** once we receive Management's response and if it does not require a suspension period for corrections, limited to 21 business days, we will issue our determination through an Eligibility Memorandum. The deadline for the issuing of this Memorandum is **August 16<sup>th</sup>, 2018**.

We will be in constant communication with you during this time. We also inform you that a request notice will be open briefly on MICI's Public Registry, where you will be able to consult the process where your Request is and where all the public documents for the case will be published.
