 - a. Masters or Ph.D degree in Education, International Development, Sociology, Economics, or other social sciences;
 - b. Five or more years of experience in strategic development in post-secondary and tertiary education;
 - c. Experience in planning in Technical and Vocational Education;
 - d. Demonstrated knowledge on International accreditation practices; and
 - e. Five or more years of experience in policy development and policy implementation.
 - f. knowledge of curriculum development planning

The Ministry of Education, Science, Technology and Innovation now invites firms to submit proposals along with a cover letter to the address below. Interested consulting firms must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services. This information should include a brief on the business, including staffing, business structure, current markets and customer base and evidence of experience and capabilities. The Consulting Firm will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the Inter-American Development Bank: GN2350-9 - Policies for the Selection and Contracting of Consultants financed by the Inter-American Development Bank (March 2011 edition).

In assessment of submissions, consideration will be given to technical competence, qualifications and experience on similar assignments, financial capability and existing commitments. All consultancies are required to prepare a sustainability framework (manual) to be reproduced throughout the system. All information must be submitted in English.
