Resumen del desempeño del proyecto en los últimos 6 meses

The main achievements of the semester were: 1) signing of the technical cooperation and loan agreements 2) completion of the Plans Communaux de Développement (PCD) in 7 communities as a part of the Community Driven Development project, which are a critical foundation for the creation of the Blue Economy plans; 3) development of PADF COVID-19 policy, communications materials, and trainings on awareness-raising and preparedness for COVID-19, in addition to distribution of masks, sanitizer, and other supplies for COVID-19 risk mitigation; 4) adaptive use of communications technology (video cameras, Zoom, etc.) to enable events and communications to proceed during the pandemic – techniques that will be valuable for future meetings and communications products; and 5) project kick-off. This semester, progress in the project's deliverables was delayed due to COVID-19 and the need for close sequencing of activities between loan, equity and grant. For example, in terms of equity activities, airport closures due to COVID-19 affected the arrival of the purchased equipment in country and its subsequent installation. Future activities will continue to involve close coordination between the inter-dependent loan, equity, and grant activities. In the coming semester, the project coordination unit expects to achieve the following: 1) complete the requirements for the first disbursement; 2) launch the mapping analysis to identify potential new collection centers and products; 3) update and adapt training materials for collection center operators; 4) select coastal communities for the Blue Economy Plans; 5) develop Blue Economy plan template and process to create Blue Economy plans; and 6) develop plans for project communications and monitoring.
