

| Year | History |
|---------|--|
| 1962 | Established Resident Registration Act |
| 1968 | Granted each resident a resident registration number |
| 1970 | Made the issuance of resident registration cards <u>compulsory</u> |
| 1985 | Finalized <u>the basic plan</u> on administration network |
| 1991 | Made a DB of resident registration information |
| 1991 | Laid the foundation for handling work through computing organization |
| 1995 | Provided <u>online services</u> regardless of the place of living |
| 2005 。 | Removed manual paperwork for resident registration |
| Present | Endeavor to improve resident services |




4. Process of registration

| Person required to be registered | Newborns residents moving to a new residence (residing for more than 30 days) |
|----------------------------------|--|
| Where to register | subordinate office(eup, myeon, dong) of lower level local government(city, county <kun>, metropolitan district)</kun> |
| Information to report | name, gender, date of birth, name of the head of household, address, etc. |
| Deadline for reporting | within 14 days of the occurrence of the cause for report, for example moving. |
| Residence registration number | • 13 digits |




5. Role and responsibility of each Gov hierarchy






6. System Concept





7. System Flow




