Dear Requesters,

After analyzing the information provided in your Request and in the subsequent correspondence, I hereby notify you that we are proceeding to register the Request in accordance with paragraph 20 of the Policy of the Independent Consultation and Investigation Mechanism ([MI-47-8](#)).

Registration is an administrative step to begin the eligibility analysis in which it is determined whether or not we can process your Request, based on the criteria of paragraph 22 of the Policy. Hereunder, I list the steps to be followed in the coming weeks:

1. **Management response:** The team responsible for the Project is simultaneously being informed of the registration of your Request so they can respond to the issues raised, offering the perspective of IDB Management. They have a maximum period of 21 business days from today to prepare this response. The due date to receive the Management Response is **January 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023**.
2. **Eligibility Analysis:** once we receive the response from the Administration, if a suspension period for corrections is not requested, in a maximum of 21 business days MICI will be issuing our determination through an Eligibility Memorandum. The deadline for the issuance of the Memorandum is **March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023**.

During this period, we will be in constant communication with you. We also inform you that a file of your Request will be opened in the [MICI Public Registry](#), where you can consult the progress of the case and where all the public documents of the case will be published.

We remain at your service to answer any questions you may have about the MICI process.
